EDUCATION: ELEMENTARY (EDE)

EDE 4930 - Spec Topics in Elem Educ (3 Credits)

The special topic will be discussed in depth based on current research and required observations in the field. The student will examine the applicability to classroom practice.

EDE 4936 - Senior Seminar- Elem Ed (3 Credits)

Capstone experience taken concurrently with the final internship. Trends and issues within the field of early childhood education are examined from the perspective of the final internship experience.

Prerequisite(s): EDE 4942 Corequisite(s): EDE 4940

EDE 4940 - Internship: Elementary Ed (9 Credits)

Provides a supervised internship in elementary education where candidates assume full teaching responsibilities. Emphasizes the demonstration of effective instructional strategies, classroom management, and professional conduct in a school or agency-based placement.

Prerequisite(s): EDE 4942 (may be taken concurrently)

Corequisite(s): RED 4942

Attribute(s): WBLI - Work based learning indicator

EDE 4942 - Integrated Field Exp; Elem. Ed (3 Credits)

Provides a supervised field experience in a special education setting where candidates observe instruction and begin to demonstrate teaching practices. Emphasizes gradual assumption of instructional responsibilities in school or agency-based placements.

Prerequisite(s): EDF 3253 and MAE 4310 and RED 4310 and RED 4350

and SCE 4310 and SSE 4343 Corequisite(s): TSL 4340

Attribute(s): WBLI - Work based learning indicator

EDE 6906 - IndStud: Elem/EarlyChildEdu (1-6 Credits)

Independent study in which students must have a contract.

EDE 6932 - Special Topics in Teaching (3 Credits)

Teachers in K-12 will refine and gain greater expertise in clinical teaching, peer support, and supervision of interns and beginning teachers and apply state standards for students and teachers.
