

NURSING UNDERGRADUATE (NUR)

NUR 3065C - Health Assessment (3 Credits)

A critical thinking, systems approach to health assessment of diverse individuals across the lifespan.

Prerequisite(s): (BSC 1085C (may be taken concurrently) or (BSC 1085 (may be taken concurrently) and BSC 1085L (may be taken concurrently))) and (BSC 1086C (may be taken concurrently) or (BSC 1086 (may be taken concurrently) and BSC 1086L (may be taken concurrently))) and NUR 3125 (may be taken concurrently) and NUR 3145 (may be taken concurrently)

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 3125 - Pathophysiology in Nursing (3 Credits)

A systems approach to the major pathologies and related physiologic responses.

Prerequisite(s): (BSC 1085C or (BSC 1085 and BSC 1085L)) and (BSC 1086C or (BSC 1086 and BSC 1086L))

NUR 3145 - Pharmacology for Nursing (3 Credits)

A systems approach to the major pharmacological classifications and alternative therapies.

Prerequisite(s): (BSC 1085C or (BSC 1085 and BSC 1085L)) and (BSC 1086C or (BSC 1086 and BSC 1086L))

NUR 3226 - Adult Health Nursing I (3 Credits)

A systems approach to nursing care of diverse individuals with alterations in health.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3065C and NUR 3125 and NUR 3145 and NUR 3825 and NUR 3829C

Corequisite(s): NUR 3226L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 3226L - Adult Health Nursing I Clinic (4 Credits)

Clinical practice experiences offer students with opportunities to provide safe, appropriate nursing care for patients with acute, chronic, or life-threatening health problems.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3065C and NUR 3125 and NUR 3145 and NUR 3825 and NUR 3829C

Corequisite(s): NUR 3226

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component, WBLI - Work based learning indicator

NUR 3286 - Gerontological Nursing (3 Credits)

A systems approach to nursing care of aging individuals and their families.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3065C and NUR 3125 and NUR 3145 and NUR 3825 and NUR 3829C

Corequisite(s): NUR 3286L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 3286L - Gerontological Nursing Clinic (1 Credits)

Clinical Practice experiences provide the student with the opportunity to apply principles of gerontological and end-of-life care.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3065C and NUR 3125 and NUR 3145 and NUR 3825 and NUR 3829C

Corequisite(s): NUR 3286

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component, WBLI - Work based learning indicator

NUR 3355 - Child Health Nursing (2 Credits)

A systems approach to health promotion, health maintenance, and nursing care of families with infants and children.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3145 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

Corequisite(s): NUR 3355L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 3355L - Child Health Nursing Clinic (1 Credits)

Students practice nursing care of families with ill infants and children and health promotion/maintenance for families with infants and children.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3145 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

Corequisite(s): NUR 3355

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component, WBLI - Work based learning indicator

NUR 3535 - Mental Health Nursing (3 Credits)

Mental health nursing focuses on concepts related to care of individuals/families experiencing mental health disorders.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3065C and NUR 3829C and NUR 3125 and NUR 3145 and NUR 3825

Corequisite(s): NUR 3535L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 3535L - Mental Health Nursing Clinical (1 Credits)

Clinical practice experiences provide students with the opportunity to provide care for patients and families experiencing mental health disorders.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3065C and NUR 3125 and NUR 3145 and NUR 3825 and NUR 3829C

Corequisite(s): NUR 3535

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component, WBLI - Work based learning indicator

NUR 3825 - Intro to Professional Nursing (2 Credits)

An introduction to the history and professional role development of nursing.

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 3829C - Foundations of Nsg Practice (4 Credits)

A foundational course emphasizing professional role development and basic nursing care.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3125 (may be taken concurrently) and NUR 3145 (may be taken concurrently) and (BSC 1085C (may be taken concurrently) or (BSC 1085 (may be taken concurrently) and BSC 1085L (may be taken concurrently))) and (BSC 1086C (may be taken concurrently) or (BSC 1086 (may be taken concurrently) and BSC 1086L (may be taken concurrently)))

NUR 3833 - Patient Care Manage in Nursing (3 Credits)

An introduction to patient care management concepts in nursing essential to promote high quality and safe patient outcomes.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3065C and NUR 3829C and NUR 3825 and NUR 3125 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 3935 - Nursing Elective (3 Credits)

In-depth examination of a current or emerging topic or issue in nursing. This course may be repeated for credit for different topics.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3125 and NUR 3065C and (NUR 3105C or NUR 3829C)

NUR 4165 - Principles of Nursing Research (3 Credits)

Examines basic principles of research methods with emphasis on critical appraisal and interpretation of nursing research and the relationship to nursing science, theory, and practice.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3065C and NUR 3125 and NUR 3145 and NUR 3825 and NUR 3829C

NUR 4167 - Research Utilization for EBP (3 Credits)

Introduction to qualitative and quantitative methods of inquiry and critical evaluation of health research literature. Focuses on improving patient outcomes through an evidence-based nursing practice approach in assessment, intervention, and evaluation.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

NUR 4169 - Evidence-Based Nursing Prac. (3 Credits)

Focus on improving patient outcomes through an evidence-based nursing practice approach in symptom assessment, intervention, and evaluation.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 4165 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 4227 - Adult Health Nursing II (3 Credits)

A systems approach to nursing care of diverse individuals with alterations in health.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3145 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

Corequisite(s): NUR 4227L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 4227L - Adult Health Nursing II Clinic (4 Credits)

Clinical practice experiences offer students with opportunities to provide safe, appropriate nursing care for patients with acute, chronic, or life-threatening health problems.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3145 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

Corequisite(s): NUR 4227

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component, WBLI - Work based learning indicator

NUR 4295C - Critical Care Nursing (3 Credits)

A systems approach to nursing care of individuals with complex, multisystem alterations in health.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 4227 and NUR 4227L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component, WBLI - Work based learning indicator

NUR 4455 - Reproductive Health Nursing (2 Credits)

Reproductive health nursing focuses on concepts related to health promotion and care of individuals and families.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3145 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

Corequisite(s): NUR 4455L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 4455L - Reproduct Health Nurs Clinic (1 Credits)

Clinical practice experiences provide the students with the opportunity to apply principles of family and reproductive health nursing.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3145 (may be taken concurrently) and NUR 3226 (may be taken concurrently) and NUR 3226L (may be taken concurrently)

Corequisite(s): NUR 4455

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component, WBLI - Work based learning indicator

NUR 4636 - Community & Pub Health Nursing (3 Credits)

Concepts of population-centered health care including health promotion, epidemiology, disaster preparedness, environmental health, and bioterrorism.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3145 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

Corequisite(s): NUR 4636L

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component

NUR 4636L - Commun & Pub Hlth Nurs Clinic (2 Credits)

Clinical practice experiences provide students with the opportunity to apply principles of community and public health nursing with aggregate populations.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3145 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L

Corequisite(s): NUR 4636

Attribute(s): SUSC - Sustainability Component, WBLI - Work based learning indicator

NUR 4807 - Transition Prof. Nursing (2 Credits)

Emphasis on professional role socialization within the discipline through examination of nursing philosophy, theory, research, and practice interrelationships.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3065C and NUR 3125 and NUR 3145 and NUR 3825 and NUR 3829C

NUR 4905 - Directed Independent Study (1-6 Credits)

Individualized pursuit of a selected topic.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3125 and NUR 3065C and NUR 3829C

Attribute(s): OLEV - On-line Course Evaluation

NUR 4930 - Special Topics in Nursing (1-6 Credits)

Examination of topics of current or special interest in nursing. The course may be repeated for different topic areas, and content may vary.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3125 and NUR 3065C and NUR 3829C

NUR 4948L - Senior Nursing Practicum (4 Credits)

Culminating clinical practice experience with a clinical preceptor that provides students opportunities to plan, deliver, and evaluate safe, competent care for patients in various health care settings. Theoretical and clinical courses must be completed as specified by the Program for preceptored practice experiences.

Prerequisite(s): NUR 3825 and NUR 3145 and NUR 3355 and NUR 3355L and NUR 3535 and NUR 3535L and NUR 3065C and NUR 3125 and NUR 3226 and NUR 3226L and NUR 3286 and NUR 3286L and NUR 3829C and NUR 4455 and NUR 4455L and NUR 4165 and NUR 4227 and NUR 4227L
