DEGREE WORKS

Degree Works is a web-based advising and degree planning tool available. The system is designed to assist students, advisors and designated faculty and staff in monitoring the degree progress of students. Degree Works organizes a student's course work in an easy to read report (degree audit) summarizing completed and missing requirements for a degree, as defined in the Florida Gulf Coast University (FGCU) catalog.

The Student Educational Planner (SEP) is a module within Degree Works that allows for long term planning. This tool enables students to work with advisors to create an academic plan that supports timely degree completion.

The Degree Works information is **unofficial** and does not take the place of regular academic advising. Students should discuss their progress toward degree completion with an advisor after reviewing the degree audit and academic plan.
