## TEACHER CREDENTIAL (CERTIFICATE)

The post-baccalaureate Teacher Credential Certificate program is designed for students with baccalaureate degrees in fields other than education, and who seek to meet the licensure/certification requirements for a Florida Educator's Certificate. Individuals completing the program meet all of the coursework requirements specified on a Florida Statement of Eligibility for educator certification. Teaching practicum and Florida Teacher Certification Exam requirements are not addressed in the program, and must be completed prior to applying for a Professional Educator's Certificate from the Florida Department of Education.

## **Program Admission Requirements**

- 1. Submission of a FGCU Post-Baccalaureate Non-Degree Certificate Application to the Office of Graduate Admissions.
- 2. A grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 or higher on a 4.0 scale for the last 60 credits attempted accruing to the undergraduate degree.
- Baccalaureate degree or higher from an institution that maintains
  accreditation by a U.S. Department of Education sanctioned
  accrediting body (https://www.ed.gov/laws-and-policy/highereducation-laws-and-policy/college-accreditation (https://
  www.ed.gov/laws-and-policy/higher-education-laws-and-policy/
  college-accreditation/)) or equivalent foreign institution as
  documented by official transcripts.
- International students must demonstrate English language proficiency in accordance with University regulation.

## Program Progression and Additional Graduation Requirements

- Students must satisfactorily complete the minimum number of credits specified by the certificate program.
- A grade of B or higher must be earned in all College of Education courses.
- · A cumulative GPA of 3.0 for all coursework in the program.
